The choir, under guest director Walter Thomson, presents a programme of glorious a cappella choral music, centred on a masterpiece of polyphonic and antiphonal writing – the great six-part motet *Tu es Petrus* by the Italian Renaissance composer, Giovanni Pierluigi da Palestrina. This leads into a performance of the "parody mass" based on material from the motet.

Adapting the ancient tradition of interspersing the movements of the mass with other liturgical elements, the programme interweaves motets from the Romantic period. Three, by Anton Bruckner, are masterly settings, demonstrating huge harmonic inventiveness and dynamic range; two are melodic pieces by Giuseppe Verdi, both of which are highly personal works of profound beauty.
